Terms & Conditions Bar Hire, Glass Hire, Candy cart Hire & Festoon lights Hire

Booking Deposit & Damage Deposit

A none refundable deposit of 20% of the total hire/service cost will be required to secure the booking this refers to all services except the fully stocked bar, details for the bar hire can be found under the Bar Hire section. A further £100 damage deposit will also be required for some services such as the vintage china, this will be returned to the hirer within 10 days of the event, minus any damage deduction where necessary. Hire of the festoon lights requires a refundable damage deposit of £25 per cable. Deductions may be up to 10 times the hire cost of the individual item depending on replacement costs. If the cost should exceed £100 the hirer will be invoiced the remaining amount. Deposits can be paid by cheque, cash or bank transfer. Please keep any damaged/broken stock so we are aware what needs to be replaced. Full payment must be received 14 days prior to the event; goods will be withheld until full payment is received.

Cancellations

Cancellations must be made thirty days prior to the event, additional costs may be incurred up to the full amount unless we are able to hire out the items.

Hire Period

The hire period is for three days unless agreed prior to the event, if you wish to extend this it must be agreed beforehand and there will be an additional charge incurred to be confirmed at the time of booking. A charge of 1.5 x the hire

rate will be charged per day for any extra days unless agreed in writing before the event. The only exception for this is for the Candy cart where bookings are for one day only, the cart may be picked up the next day if the venue allows.

Delivery/collection

We will deliver & collect for free within a 5 mile radius of our business head office (Consett Co. Durham DH8 6HG) after which a charge will be incurred for travel costs depending on the distance. This charge will be agreed at the final confirmation of booking. Goods can also be collected & returned to our head office in Consett Co. Durham at an agreed time.

All items should be inspected by the hirer when picked up/delivered if this does not happen we will assume the goods are deemed acceptable with no damages.

Packaging

It is the hirer's responsibility to ensure all items are wrapped up in the packaging provided. If this is not adhered to a deduction will be made from the damage deposit to cover time spent waiting/packaging by nickynoo quirky weddings & events. Any breakages will be deducted from the deposit for glasses and light bulbs etc..

All glasses must be returned washed unless a glass washing fee has been agreed prior to the booking. If glasses are returned dirty there will be an appropriate amount deducted from the deposit.

Festoon Lights

Festoon Lights are for hire only, it is the responsibility of the customer to erect the lights, cable ties & spare bulbs are provided. The lights must be picked up and returned to the main office unless a delivery price is agreed prior.

Liability

nickynoo quirky weddings & events cannot accept responsibility for any damage to persons or property or injury caused by the items/services which are under the hirer's responsibility, or any liability for any claims that come about from any event concerning or involving items/services hired by us.

Bar Hire

For events of over 60 people the fully stocked vintage style bar is free to hire. For any events fewer than 60 people price is on request. We require a refundable damage deposit of £100 to secure the booking; this will be returned to the customer within 14 days after the event minus any damages. The deposit will not be returned if the event is cancelled by the customer. You will need to provide bank details for the deposit to be returned via bank transfer.

A surcharge of £200.00 will apply to all hirers in the event of cancellation of the event and no notice being given to us in advance resulting in our arrival at the venue as booked

The fully stocked bar comes inclusive of staff. Cocktails and any additional request must be agreed prior to the event.

Bar opening hours and set up and clearing away times must be agreed beforehand with sufficient time allowed to set up and pack away and vacate the venue after the event. You must

inform us of any time restrictions, parking restrictions or parking height restrictions

A mileage charge may be incurred for events outside of the catchment area covered; this will be agreed at time of booking.

Consumption of own drinks condition - Pay Bar Customers - Guests are required to purchase their drinks from the bar we provide for your event. This means that guests are not permitted to bring their own drinks for consumption at the venue. This is a licensing condition for which we retain responsibility. We reserve the right to confiscate unauthorised drinks or remove them from the premises.

Reception/arrival drinks arranged by either you or another provider are permitted providing they are for consumption during the pre-meal period. We would ask that you inform us if this is the case in advance so that we know what arrangements have been made.

Table wine and all other table drinks including drinks for toasting arranged by either you or another provider are permitted providing they are for consumption during the meal only. All drinks must then be removed from the tables after the meal. We would ask that you inform us if this is the case in advance so that we know what arrangements have been made. All other drinks provided for your event must be supplied by us

Pay Bar Customers - We operate a strict policy on underage drinking. Any guests that appear to be under 21 years of age may be challenged for photo I.D. Acceptable formats include driving licenses, passports or pass approved I.D. car

Pay Bar Customers - We are responsible for the operation of your bar in accordance with the licensing act 2003. Therefore the premises used for the event, including marquees or private houses, will have been licensed to permit the retailing of alcohol for the duration of the event and the licensing law will be in operation. If no such license exists for the premises the bar will not be permitted to open. A copy of the license must be available for inspection upon our arrival. If you wish for us to apply for a temporary events notice this must be agreed at the time of booking, we will carry a copy of the license with us.

Gin wizz mobile bar

The mobile bicycle bar Gin Wizz has an 80 drink minimum unless booked alongside the fully stocked bar where there will be a £50.00 charge for the bicycle this is none refundable. If welcome drinks are booked either with the fully stocked bar or the bicycle we require a none refundable deposit of 20%.

Sweet Cart

A 100 grams per person will be provided made up of a minimum of six types of sweet/confectionery/savoury snack unless agreed otherwise prior to the event. nickynoo quirky weddings & events will endeavour to provide food items chosen by the hirer where possible, we reserve the right to provide suitable replacements where this is not possible. nickynoo quirky weddings & events take no responsibility for any food allergy or food intolerance for any members of the public and cannot guarantee the ingredients/ presence of any allergens in the sweets/snacks/confectionery/food. The hire period is for a

minimum of three hours any additional time must be agreed prior to the event. Please refer to the additional sweet cart terms and conditions appropriate to the package booked.
